The service runs from door-to-door based only on the address listed on the members' file. Passengers will be dropped off and collected at street level as close to the residence as reasonably possible.

Drop off at train stations and shopping centers will not be permitted.

PASSENGER CODE OF CONDUCT

- No Food or Drink to be consumed on the bus.
- Smoking and vaping is not permitted on the bus.
- Passengers must remain seated at all times.
- Seat belts must be worn at all times.
- Please register with the bus driver before you board the bus.
- Please do not distract the driver whilst the vehicle is in motion.
- Violence and aggression will not be tolerated.
- Passengers are responsible for their own belongings.
- The driver may refuse to collect a passenger who is deemed to be intoxicated or is being a nuisance to others.
- The driver may refuse to collect a passenger who is demonstrating aggressive or dangerous behaviour.
- The driver may refuse to carry a passenger or may eject them from the bus if causing a nuisance to or harassing other passengers prior to or during a journey.
- The driver may refuse to allow a passenger to board the bus if they do not adhere to the dress standards of the Club.
